As I thought, the heir to Ospisdale was a cabinet maker.
Sheep-farmer, road-maker and cabinet maker: must have been a
versatile man.

The statute labour list may require some explaining. The vast majority of people paid 2 shillings. People renting holdings over £5 paid more in proportion. As you will see most holdings paid rent in money but some still paid in grain, measured by the boll (B). The list also records why some people were excused paying. Normally such lists included offspring who, for instance as fishermen or labourers, were liable for payment as well as the heads of household. This list appears to be merely a list of householders and, where appropriate, tenants paying over £5 rent. Hugh McCulloch didn't get it quite right!
